



Understanding Mesothelioma

This new book focuses on the experience of living with mesothelioma from the perspective of people with mesothelioma and their families. The book explains the lived experience of mesothelioma and how it impacts on the lives of those with the illness, and their families.

The book provides some context regarding mesothelioma, what it is and why it occurs. The book then profiles the range of experiences across the patient pathway in order to highlight implications for care delivered by professionals and staff in health care, social care and the charitable/voluntary sector.

Insights are drawn from experienced based research conducted by members of the Mesothelioma UK Research Centre at the University of Sheffield, the wider mesothelioma research community, published literature plus various topic experts.

The book has a UK focus but draws on evidence from international research where available and appropriate.

Whilst mesothelioma is a rare disease, the contents of this book may well be relevant to those working with people with other rare/terminal diseases and conditions.
