Evaluation Report






The SPAIIN hybrid Annual Education Event was held at COSLA Edinburgh. This was the first face to face event held by SPAIIN since 2019.

61 people attended the event. Of those 61 attendees, **67.2%** (41) provided feedback to our Event Evaluation.


32 attended in person and 29 online. Please see attendance by health board, below:












Overall quality of education provided by event

Constructive feedback highlighted the need for more controlled timings. The timings ran over due to valuable discussions taking place as part of the presentations, however, this time was made up in the afternoon, with the event still finishing on schedule.

A hybrid approach allowed valuable networking for those who attended in-person, as well as offering staff unable to attend for the full day due to work or personal commitments, to also attend online.
